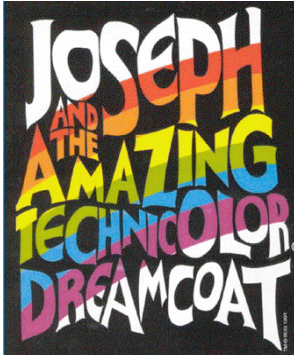

Country Gate Players To Present Hit Musical, Joseph And The Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat

Country Gate Players will present the family musical, *Joseph And The Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat*, July 17, 24, and 31, at 8:00 p.m., as well as August 1, at 2:00 p.m. The show, with a popular score by Tim Rice and Andrew Lloyd Webber, will be performed at the Country Gate Playhouse, 114 Greenwich Street, Belvidere, New Jersey.



Beginning its life in 1967 as a 20-minute "pop cantata" for a school Easter concert, "Joseph" was revived and expanded in the mid-'70s and eventually made its way to Broadway in 1982. This

lively interpretation has gone on to charm audiences around the world with its excitement, energy, and eclectic musical variety. In the theatrical retelling of the Biblical story of Joseph, his eleven brothers and the coat of many colors, this magical musical is full of unforgettable songs including *Any Dream Will Do*, *Close Every Door To Me* and *One More Angel*.

The Country Gate production features an outstanding cast of renown area performers. They include: Scott Reyes, of Hackettstown, as the title character. Reyes has been a featured regional performer for many years, perhaps best known for his turn as Jesus, in *Godspell*. Gina

Scurato, of Harmony Township, is cast as the Narrator, Ms. Scurato, who also directs the production, was last seen onstage in the Country Gate production of *The Sound of Music*.
